**Notification of carriageway improvement works in Hornton Lane between Lane Close and Church Lane / Little Lane, Horley and an associated road closure.**

I write to inform you that Oxfordshire Highways intend to carry out carriageway patching at this location. Please find a map on the reverse of this letter.

The work is planned to commence on the 9<sup>th</sup> April 2018 between the hours of 9:00am and 3:30pm and will take approximately five days to complete. The Hornton Lane will be closed from the Banbury Lane to Little Lane/ Church Lane during the working hours, but open outside of these times.

Whilst work is being carried out it will be necessary for all parked vehicles to be removed which will help us to deliver a high standard of workmanship and minimise the period of disruption to you.

Access for frontages will be maintained from both ends of the closure where possible, but no through traffic excepting emergency vehicles will be possible between Lane Close and Holly Tree Farm due to our works, and the narrow road width at this location. A signed diversion will operate for those unfamiliar with the local road network. Please note that Little Lane and Church Lane will be reserved for access only, and an advisory sign erected at the Wroxton Lane end stating access only, no through traffic. As well as being factually correct as the road will have a manned barrier at the Church Lane end this is also to deter vehicles using this single track road inappropriately.

We will endeavour to maintain access to those properties directly affected by the closure. However, there may be occasions when this is not possible and I apologise for any inconvenience this may cause. If you have any concerns please speak to the contractors on site for possible day to day changes in access arrangements.

This applies in particular to Dairy Court, Smarglen, Stonecroft and Park Cottage. These are the only properties likely to their access compromised during the working times. If possible please make alternative arrangements if you need to enter or exit these properties during the working times.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your cooperation and assistance in allowing us to complete these improvement works for you.
