### About the workshop

Sally is an experienced artist, designer and teacher who, in a very relaxed garden studio setting, will guide you through some of the basic techniques of screen printing onto fabric. (See short biography on page 2.) She'll also bring along some of her own work as inspiration.

You will learn how to prepare silhouette patterns and screen print onto fabric using paper stencils. (Don't worry if you think you can't draw or have never designed anything like this before - we have a wide range of charming pre-cut silhouettes you can use to assemble your own design.)

You'll start off using the screens, inks (in two colours) and squeegees to print onto paper and then progress to fabric. You can choose one of the following fabric items to print and take away at the end of the workshop:

- Cushion cover 50cm x 50cm
- Cotton shopping bag
- Or, if you prefer, create your own piece of printed fabric ideal for taking home to make your own creations, such as lampshades or cosmetic bags. You might also like to embroider it later.

This workshop is perfect for anyone with an interest in screen printing, either beginners or those who want to build upon existing skills or relive happy memories of screen printing back at school or college.

There will be a short mid-morning break for tea, coffee and cake in the Cromwells Garden Room.

Note: Some participants get the bug and then want to print a series of cushion covers or cards or even make their own presents for Christmas 2019. (We have festive stencils available). If you would like to print more items you can either come along to another scheduled screen printing session with Sally (if there are available places) or, if there is enough demand, we will set up a second date to suit a group of six.



### What you need to bring

We will provide all the materials you need, including blank bags, cushion covers and paper on which to print your designs.

Because the inks will stain, we suggest you wear old clothes and bring an overall, preferably with sleeves, and an old small towel.

### Price

£35 per person. Includes refreshments. Payable in advance.

### Size of class

Six people max (aged 18 and over).

### Disabled access

Regrettably, our workshops and talks are not accessible by wheelchair. The Cromwells garden and house have lots of stone steps and terraces.
